

Rado watches look good, but that's not their only quality. They also offer an unrivalled wearing experience. This is ensured by sophisticated design and exceptional materials - the secret of their very personal DNA.

What feels so smooth and lightweight is the result of many years of research and development. Our experts have reinvented production techniques, refined shaping methods and created colours where otherwise only black and white could be seen. Each of these materials is a star in itself. And a worthy contender for the international master's title.

High-tech ceramic

The success of high-tech ceramics in the art of watchmaking continues unabated. This fills us with pride. After all, this success story at Rado began in 1986. Back then, we used black hightech ceramic for the first time in the bracelet links of the legendary Integral. This groundbreaking material,

which had never been used in watchmaking in this way before, conquered the hearts and wrists of watch enthusiasts around the world with its scratch resistant, lightweight and skin-friendly qualities.

Most high-tech ceramic watches from Rado are created on the basis of zirconium oxide powder with an ultrafine micrometre grain size. It is an extremely pure and finely calibrated artificially produced substance. Its advantage compared to conventional ceramics: high-tech ceramic is a very compact, high-density material. What's more, it does not have to be specially glazed to achieve a high-gloss

Ceramic is also an excellent colour carrier. Introduced by Rado in 1986, the high-tech ceramic with its deep black sheen has had a lasting impact not only on watch design in general but also on the image of our brand. At the same time, it has paved the way for a multifaceted colour palette, to which we continue to add new tones - as recently with nine shades of the famous colour theory of Le Corbusier. Each new ceramic colour is the result of an elaborate development process lasting many years and represents a real breakthrough.

Plasma high-tech ceramic

Our pioneering plasma high-tech ceramic combines the qualities of hightech ceramic with the unique shine of metal – without using metal.

What sounds like magic is state-of-theart technology: finished white ceramic

a special debinding process.

pieces are placed in a high-performance kiln, the plasma column of which is heated to 20,000°C. During this, gases are released at low pressure, which penetrate the ceramic surface and change its molecular structure. The original white colour of the ceramic thus changes to a warm metallic grey. As the radiant colour is part of the material, it will never fade or lose its shine. And even though the procedure changes the colour of the ceramic, it does not impair its qualities. Plasma high-tech ceramic is still lightweight, scratch resistant and hypoallergenic. We think this is pure magic!

Hardmetal

It may sound surprising, but the sight of hardmetal makes our hearts beat a little bit faster. After all, this is how it all began at Rado in terms of hightech materials. The aim at the time was to develop a scratch resistant watch. This is why Rado designed

the unmistakable DiaStar 1 in 1962 with a mix of materials consisting of a ceramic - tungsten carbide - and a metal binder. The material possesses high density, is heavier than high-tech ceramic and is extremely scratch resistant. It proved to be an ideal starting point for decades of material research, development and technology. Without hardmetal, we could probably only dream of high-tech ceramics in watchmaking today.

Sapphire crystal

After diamonds, sapphire crystal is one of the world's hardest materials and is characterised by its high degree of transparency - no wonder, then, that it has long been one of our declared favourite materials. In fact, Rado was the first manufacturer to use sapphire crystal on a large scale for a watch: for the Rado DiaStar 1 in 1962. In this way, we have constantly set new standards in the watch industry, at a time when brands were particularly turning to easy-to-scratch mineral glass or

The sapphire crystal used at Rado is "grown" in a laboratory using the Verneuil method. From a single "seedling", a "boule" is created. This cylindrical piece of synthetic sapphire is laboriously cut, polished, processed and fitted with an anti-reflective coating. Today, all new Rado watches are fitted with sapphire crystal as standard, which protects the dial.

$Ceramos^{TM}$

The best of both worlds: this innovative composite combines the hardness of a high ceramic content (around 90% titanium carbide) with the shine of a metal alloy. In a sense, CeramosTM is a further development of hardmetal: it offers the same scratch resistant qualities with a significantly lower specific weight.

Since its use in the injection moulding process from 2012, CeramosTM has become a popular addition to stainless steel watches. Besides increased scratch resistance for important elements such as bezels and bracelet links, it also adds a good splash of colour. In 2018, we perfected this technology to dress our ground-breaking monobloc housing in steeland rose gold-coloured CeramosTM — a further truly gleaming highlight in our material history.

NATO STRAP EASY CLIP SYSTEM - A 'HOW TO' GUIDE





STEP 1Place the watch face down on a protected surface.



STEP 2 REMOVING THE STRAP Push in and simultaneously lift up the spring bar. Remove the nato strap.



STEP 3 ADDING A NEW STRAP
Place the watch face down on a protected surface.
Position the nato strap with the clasp at 12 o'clock.
The anchor should be in the center of the watch.
Insert the spring bar into the holes.



STEP 4
Slide the strap through the loop and pull into place.
Adjust the strap to ensure that the watch head is in



STEP 5Check that the nato strap is firmly attached.

digital items into the analogue world, thus they grabbed inspiration from digital displays and from the square Rado ceramic watch from the 1980s. The case and bracelet are both made of black matt high-tech ceramic that give it a purist appeal, and the hands are covered by Luminous white SuperLumiNova® that stand out during day and night.







colour theory. The result is a striking timepiece made of yellow high-tech ceramic, which holds a matt black dial with silver-coloured concentric circles, with white minute and hour hands, and a neon red second hand. Its date display at 3 o'clock features the Tej Chauhan brand typography. It's paired with a "pillowed" yellow leather strap which adds to the nostal-gic yet forward looking design.




